- Penalties for Ommitted Entires
 - Penalties will be directed to Carrier, even if 3rd party logistics is involved
- Overstays Annoucement
 - Maximum of 5 days before GO storage
- CBP Cybersecurity Desktop date set for March 2024

1. **Non-Resident Importers:** In the past, when a broker could not get the assigned importer number from the foreign importer of record (client), the Laredo Entry Section would help us determined this number.

2. **Request for General Information.** Member brokers have sent requests for guidance related to Requests for general infromation to import specialits, but they do not receive responses.

3. **CTPAT Detention.** CTPAT Customs Brokers that are CTPAT Certified are being canceled due to not reporting Contamination incidents whenever they are the broker of record.
 - a. What are CBP's procedures when an Entry issued by a broker are involved?
 - b. Does CBP notify the broker? SCSSs require that they be notified of every incident or otherwise they will be subject to cancellation of certified status.
